2022 WFF SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION IS OPEN!



SPREAD THE WORD!!! The Williams-Franklin Foundation (WFF) is offering 20 \$5000 scholarships to college students. Applicants who are interested in applying must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Currently enrolled student at an accredited Historically Black College and University at the time of the application submission;
- Completed at least 24 academic credit hours by the end of the spring 2022 semester;
- 3. Obtained a cumulative GPA of 2.7 or above;
- Cannot have a familial relationship with members of the Williams-Franklin Foundation Board, Selection Committee, or staff:
- 5. United States citizen at the time of application submission; and
- If awarded the scholarship, the awardee must participate in 2/3 of WFF-sponsored activities.

The application deadline is **April 15, 2022, at 11:59 PM EST**. No application materials will be considered after this date and time. Apply here!
